#### **About the Jack Peckham Memorial Scholarships**

The New England CCIM Chapter is pleased to offer two (2) scholarships in 2023. These scholarships are provided in honor of John “Jack” Peckham, CCIM. Jack was the founder of the New England CCIM Chapter in 1975 and served as the First Chapter President as well as many other positions within the New England CCIM Chapter throughout his career. Jack was also a past President of the Massachusetts Association of Realtors and longstanding luminary in the Boston and National real estate community.

#### **About the New England CCIM Chapter**

#### **Scholarship Program Guidelines**

**Recipients of the scholarship awards will have the choice of either a full tuition reimbursement for the CI101 or CI103 course hosted by the New England CCIM Chapter in 2023 or a \$1,000 tuition reimbursement for a qualified CCIM designation course successfully completed online or hosted by another chapter.**

The New England CCIM course scholarship was created to support qualified real estate professionals in their efforts to achieve the CCIM designation. Recipient should exemplify the high caliber of professionals that comprise the CCIM Institute.

## Scholarship Selection Criteria

Includes the following:

- Each applicant should be able to demonstrate a commitment to a commercial real estate career (see application).
- Each applicant should be able to demonstrate active participation with the New England CCIM Chapter, such as attending events, volunteering or as a dues paying member (see application).
- Recipient of this scholarship should have a need for financial assistance.

## Scholarship Value

Recipient will have the choice to receive either a full-tuition reimbursement for the CI101 or CI103 course hosted by the New England CCIM Chapter in 2023 or a **\$1,000** reimbursement to offset the cost of one of the following CCIM designation courses: **CI 101, CI 102, CI 103 or CI 104** taken online or hosted by another CCIM Chapter. **Two** individual scholarships will be awarded to **two** different recipients.

## Procedure

Applications are submitted directly to the New England CCIM Chapter through [NewEnglandCCIM@ccim.net](mailto:NewEnglandCCIM@ccim.net). Questions regarding the process or application should also be directed there. Upon successful completion of a qualified CCIM designation course, the scholarship winner should contact [NewEnglandCCIM@ccim.net](mailto:NewEnglandCCIM@ccim.net) to provide a copy of their course registration receipt and evidence of achieving a passing grade. Once approved, the scholarship winner will receive the applicable Scholarship Value as a reimbursement from the New England CCIM Chapter. Scholarships will be awarded for designation courses taken between May 15, 2023 – December 31, 2023. **The scholarship will not be awarded for courses taken prior to May 14, 2023.**
